What's in it for me? This is a **FREE** workshop designed to promote the preservation of an American art form: Bluegrass Music. Each participant will receive:

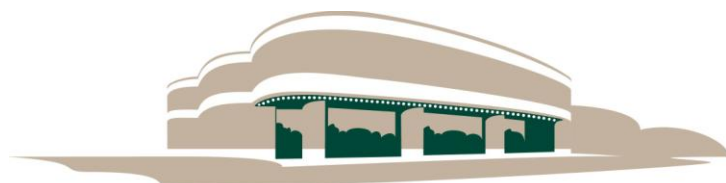
